MINUTES OF SUB- COMMITTEE MEETING FOR THE SCHEME OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PRESERVATION AND CONSERVATION OF MANUSCRIPTS, RARE BOOKS, OLD AND RARE DOCUMENTS, RECORDS OF HISTORY

2014-2015

Meeting of the Sub-Committee for the above scheme was held on 15 October, 2014 in National Archives of India, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Shri V. Srinivas, Director General/Joint Secretary, National Archives of India, Ministry of Culture. The present meeting has been convened in continuation to the Grants Committee meeting held on 27 August, 2014.

- 2. The members who were present in the meeting is at Annexure-I
- 3. Welcoming the Members, the Chairman apprised them of the aims and objectives of the scheme and informed the Committee that the maximum limit of the grant is ₹10.00 lakhs per project per year. The Chairman emphasized the need for a proper monitoring mechanism for better utilization of the grant amount released. Since during the Grants Committee meeting held on 27 August, 2014 had encouraged support for conservation and restoration of Manuscripts, Rare Books etc., instead of purchase of equipments for the same during the Sub-Committee meeting Chairman has emphasized on issuing a supplementary notification for fixing uniform remuneration for the conservationist experts. Subsequently, under the Chairmanship of the Sub-Committee discussed all the 16 deferred cases in Part A-1 of the Agenda that includes cases from North-East State which were taken up for consideration and the following decisions was taken by the Sub-Committee.
- Part A-I- North-East State: Sub-Committee considered 16 cases complete in all respect and recommended 5 cases from the State of Assam.

Approved Projects Cost 75% Central Share

= ₹11,75,000/-= ₹8,81,250/-= ₹2,93,750/-

25% Matching Share

= ₹11,75,000/-

Grants Committee recommended a total grant

[Total of Approved project cost including grantees matching share @ 25% including of Part-A -I]

75% Central Govt. Share is $\frac{8}{8}$,81,250/- of the above amount of $\frac{1}{7}$ 11,75,000/- and thus the 1st installment of $\frac{4}{7}$ 40,625/- would be released to the Grantee who have submitted the complete Bond and other papers. The 2nd installment would be released as re-imbursement once the Utilization Certificate of the entire grant is submitted by the Grantee.
